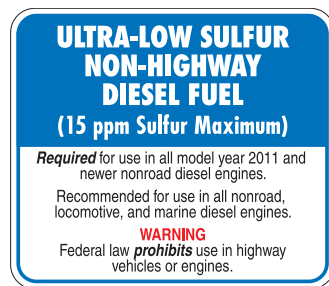
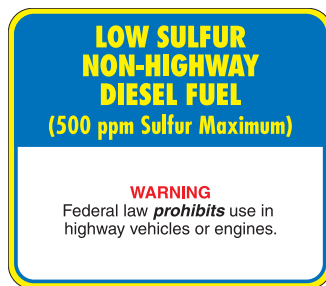


# API Suggested Non-Highway (NRLM) Diesel Fuel Pump Labels

Compliant with EPA 40 CFR paragraph listed under each label



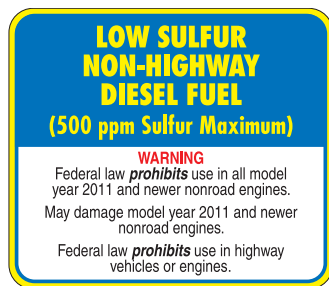

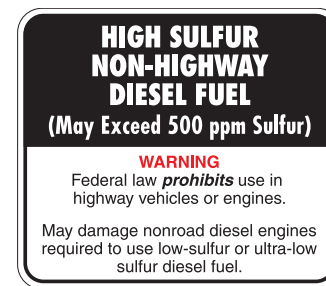

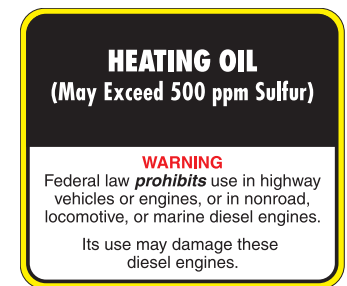

- Titles of all labels (e.g., Low Sulfur Non-Highway, Non-Road, Locomotive, and Marine [NRLM] Diesel Fuel) are in 24-point type, Sulfur Level Cap Designations (e.g., [500ppm Sulfur Maximum]) are in 20-point type, and all other required language is in 14-point type as approved by the EPA.
- Labels shall be on the upper two-thirds of the pump in a location where they are clearly visible.
- Pumps must be labeled by June 1, 2007.

\*Early use of 80.572(c) is approved by EPA.
